sandy, pebbly, or rocky shore of a



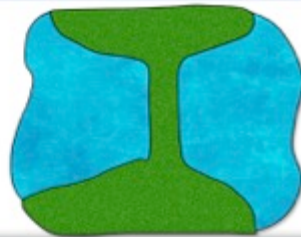
mountain

a large, steep area of land which usually rises more than 1,000 feet



isthmus

narrow strip of land that connects 2 large land masses and separates 2 bodies of water



peninsula

a piece of land that is surrounded by water on 3 sides



canyon

a deep, narrow valley, usually with steep sides and a river flowing through it



lake

a body of water completely surrounded by land



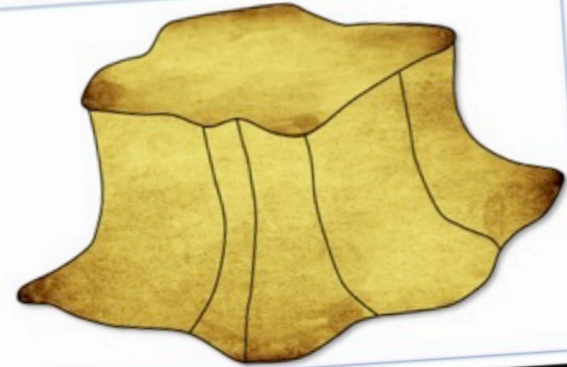

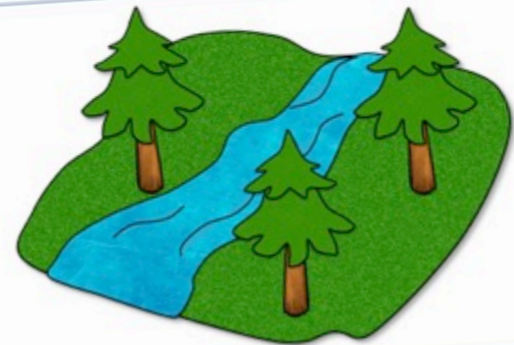
Plateau

## basin

a raised area of land; not as high as a mountain



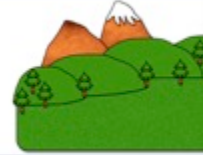
## isthmus

## island



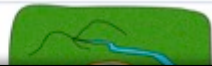

a large, natural stream which flows into a larger body of water



## volcano

a mountain or hill with a crater through which lava, rock, or gas erupts



## wetlands

water ecosystems, such as swamps, marshes, and mud flats



## gulf

part of the ocean or sea that extends into land
