

American football originated at universities throughout the United States in the late 1800s. On November 6, 1869, the first college football game was held in New Brunswick. New Jersey, where the Rutgers defeated Princeton with a score of 6-4. This match, as well as many other first college footballs games, was similar to soccer. Harvard University, however, preferred a rugby-soccer style of game, called the "Boston Game". Before long, several colleges were playing rugby-style football.

So how did football change into the game we recognize today? A Yale medical student named Walter Camp played halfback and also served as his team's captain. He helped make some big changes to the game. First, a team would have to give up the ball after failing to move down the field a certain distance in a specific number of "downs". He also introduced the 11-man team, the line of scrimmage, the quarterback position, and the scoring system we use today. Camp went on to coach the Yale team to a 57-2 record from 1888-1892. He is known today as the "Father of American Football".

The first championship game for the Intercollegiate Football Association was played in New York City on Thanksgiving Day in 1876. While football is still a big Thanksgiving tradition, New Year's Day became the main holiday for college football championships. The "Rose Bowl" football championship began in 1916, and is still a popular event today!

The first professional football player was Yale's William "Pudge" Hefflefinger, who received \$500 to play for the Allegheny Athletic Association against their big rival, the Pittsburgh Athletic Club in 1892. The popularity of football continued to grow, and professional football officially began when four clubs joined together to form the American Professional Football Association in 1920.
