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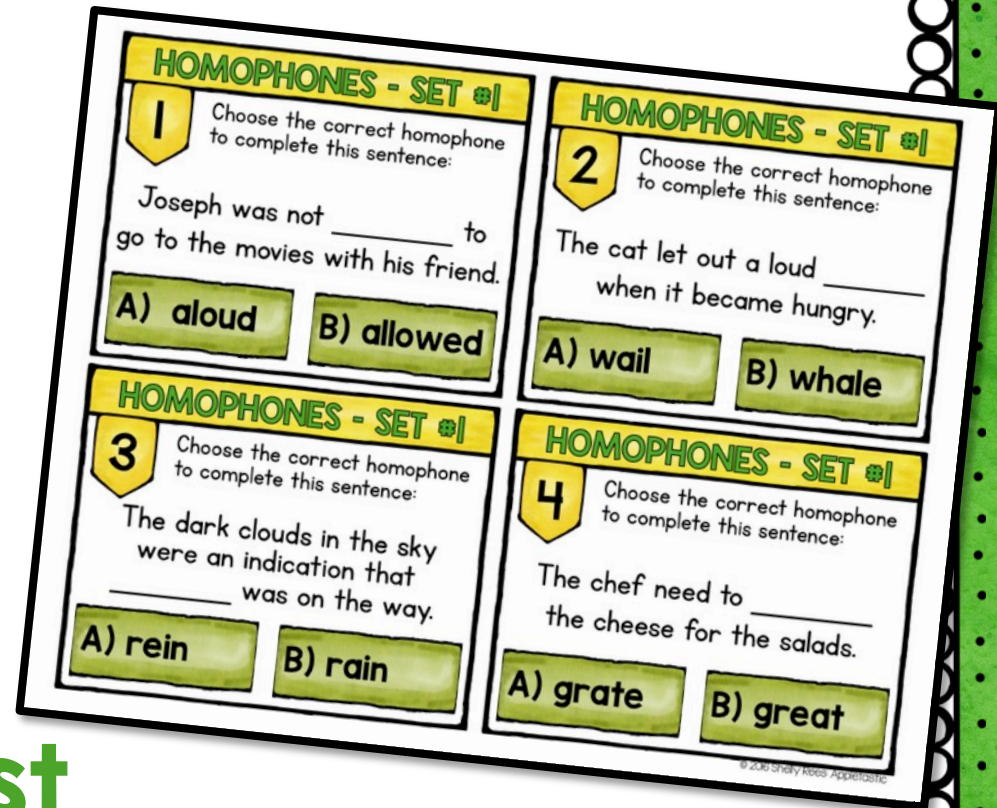

Suggestions for Using

Task cards are incredibly versatile. Once you've used them in your classroom, you will wonder how you ever lived without them. This set of task cards has 32 Fact and Opinion Cards on the topic. I suggest printing them on cardstock and laminating for durability. All cards in this set are placed on the top, so you can easily organize them in a storage area.

Here are some suggestions for use:

- Use in centers.** So easy to set up and use, you will love these centers!
- As homework.** Make a greyscale copy of the cards and send home in place of a worksheet.
- Test prep.** Mix cards from different sets to create a great set of review questions for test prep.
- Partner work.** You can either give each student a card together or you can use your document camera to project one onto your screen so that all partners can see the question at once.
- Board games.** In an exit slip activity, students earn points for correctly answering a task card.
- Exit slips.** Give students a task card and have them project the same task card onto the screen.
- Room the Room.** Tape task cards around the room. Students travel with their partners, answering the different cards.
- Tutoring time or individual work.** Use task cards to work down significantly with students.
- Interactive Notebooks.** Make students cut and paste cards into their notebooks to demonstrate understanding.
- Line up and transition time.** Use task cards for extra few minutes while students wait for the next subject!
